NCC REPORT (2017-18)

Thirty Cadets were enrolled in the first year on 18th August 2017 to make a complete strength of 104. As a part of institutional training, first year cadets had 15 parades (60 Hours) and second and final year cadets had 17.5 (70 Hours) of stipulated parades.
