

NCC Annual Report (2018-2019)

Revered Secretary Maharaj, Principal, Staff and my dear cadets, I am extremely happy and proud to present the annual report of the Training Year 2018-2019.

Forty Five Cadets were enrolled in the first year on 23rd July 2018 to make a complete strength of One Hundred and Four Cadets. As a part of institutional training, first year cadets had 15 parades and second and final year cadets had 17.5 stipulated parades. Ninety Five vacancies were utilized for the camps organized at both state and national level. Cadets' representation and performance in 'B' and 'C' Certificate Examinations have been outstanding.

Camps:
